

JOLLY'S DRINKS CORNWALL CRICKET LEAGUE

Rule Alterations/Amendments agreed at the 2016 AGM were :-

- 3.4.2 Proposals to alter the constitution or rules must be received by the League Secretary by 1st October. Proposals must also be seconded in writing by 'two' other current named CCL clubs.
- 3.9.5 At the AGM, a 60% majority of votes cast is required to pass any alteration, amendment, correction or change of League Rules, whilst a simple majority is required for those LMC persons described in 3.8.
- 3.4.4 Only those proposals that gain 50% or more of votes cast will be carried forward to the League AGM
- 10.1 The CCL shall adopt 5-tier structure system to comprise:-
- 10.1.1 Premier – ECB Premier League countywide division and
- 10.1.2 Tier 1 – County Division 1 & Division 2 with separate East and West sections and
- 10.1.3 Tier 2 – Divisions 3 & 4 with separate East and West sections and
- 10.1.4 Tier 3 - Division 5 (East & West) & Division 6 (East, West & Central)
- 10.5 All matters relating to the composition of the divisions of the League, including promotion and relegation for the subsequent season, may not be altered after 31st December each year. The season shall be deemed to commence, for all administrative purposes, on January 1st. The season shall conclude at 23.59 hours on 30th September.
- 10.8 Delete - Clubs shall withdraw its lowest team.....
- 15.1.1.3 Clubs in the Premier & Tiers 1 & 2 MUST use the online registration system on their Club Play Cricket site to register players throughout the year. Provided that a new player's registration is received and recorded on Play-Cricket before the start of a league match, then that player may be selected to play immediately. No player aged 18 years or older on the day of registration or re-registration can be registered after 31st July and before the last match of the current season.
- 15.2.2.2 A player can be transferred to play for his/her new club provided the transfer, fully authenticated, is received and recorded on Play-Cricket by 10pm on a Thursday. That player may be selected to play from the immediately following Saturday match day.
With the exception of Tier 3, there are NO transfers or new registrations after 31 July until the end of the season.
- 15.3.1.2 Clubs in Tiers 2 & 3 that play an unregistered player will be automatically deducted 5pts for each of the first three offences in any season, any subsequent breach will result in a 10 point deduction.
- 15.4 Loan Players
- 15.4.1 Players may be loaned freely between all teams in Tiers 2 and 3, with free team selection permitted, as per Rule 17.4.4. No prior LMC agreement is required, but clubs must advise the LMC of any loan players by placing the letter "L" after the name on the match result sheet.
- 15.4.2 There shall be no restriction on the number of clubs a player may be loaned to or on the number of loan players allowed in any particular match.
- 15.4.3 Should a match in Tier 3 be mutually rescheduled and played on the immediate Sunday following its scheduled match day (or immediately prior to a scheduled Bank Holiday Monday fixture), then that match is also defined as being played on a normal scheduled match day and loan players may be used, except: No regular Tier 2 player (as defined in Rule 17.4.5.2) may be loaned to a Tier 3 team for a rescheduled match as described in 15.4.3.
- 15.4.3.1 No player may play for two league teams over the same weekend (except where there are two scheduled match days, i.e. a Bank Holiday).
- 15.4.4 For all other rescheduled fixtures as defined in Rules 17.2, loan players are subject to Rules 17.4.5.1 and 17.4.5.2.
- 15.4.5 Contact and agreement must be made between either the Secretary and /or the Chairman of both Clubs.
- 17.2.1.1 There shall be no re-scheduling of any matches in the Premier & Tier 1;
- 17.2.1.3 Clubs in Tier 3 may arrange fixtures on Sunday by mutual consent. (Rule 17.2.1.2 applies)
- 17.4.4 On normal scheduled league match days, where at least the top two teams are representing a club, clubs may select, promote or demote players as they see fit. (see also 17.6.1). Rule 17.4.5 to apply on days where a club's 1st or 2nd XI is without a fixture."
- Should a match in Tier 3 be mutually rescheduled and played on the immediate Sunday following its scheduled league match day, that match is also defined as being played on a normal scheduled league match day – it is not a fixture played under rules 17.4.5.
- 17.4.5.1 On the 1st August, or thereafter in a season, a player who has played 75% or more games, that have started, for a higher Division team are not permitted to play for a lower Division team unless they have not played in the three previous games, that have started, for the higher Division team.
- 18.1 The Premier League to comprise of 10 teams playing each other each other home & away in 50 over 'Win/Lose' matches played on Saturdays/ B.H. Mondays.
- 18.15.1 Premier 50/50 Cup semi-finals removed.
- 19.2.1 Starting times may be rescheduled 30 minutes either side of the scheduled start time by mutual agreement between both Captains and any independent umpires. The arrangement of a start time outside of these parameters requires the agreement of the LMC.
- 19.6 Tiers 1, 2 & 3 No bowler may bowl more than 25% of the overs.
- 20.2.1 Tier 2 - All matches will start at 1.30pm throughout the season.
- 20.3.1 Tier 2 - Each side shall bat for no more than 45 overs.
- 20.9.1 Tier 2 - In addition to MCC Law 25, the following shall apply in Tier 2 matches. For offside wides, a delivery that passes outside of a line drawn (in blue) seventeen inches (17") inside either return crease, will be called and signalled a wide. A legside wide shall be called and signalled if the ball passes on the leg side of the wicket, without touching any part of the striker's person or bat and outside of where the batsman would be standing in his normal position.
- 21.8.4.1 Tier 3 - Batting Bonus Points, 1 batting point shall be awarded for every 40 runs up 200
- 25.5.4 The winners of the W T Edwards Cup will host the Nat West T20 Regional Finals Day when it is held in the county
- 25.1.9 T20 Competitions - The LMC will provide new 'pink' balls for each innings for each semi-final and final.
