Change of League Name

With immediate effect the League will now be known as the '**LWC Drinks Cornwall Cricket League**' in place of '*Jolly's Drinks*'. It is the same company (based at Pool, Redruth) but the name reflects they are part of a national company. *Jolly's Drinks* first sponsored the League's *Sunday KO Cup* in 1995 and became the main League sponsor in 1998 (*Nigel Jolly & Chairman Syd Trembath pictured right*). This will be the 20th consecutive season. Overseas Player Regulations 2017

Clubs have been kept up to date recently with the changes to criteria as laid down by the Home Office and ECB. The LMC have appointed Deputy Chairman Dave Eggins as its '*Overseas Administration Officer*'. He has already provided guidelines that have been issued to clubs, following consultations with ECB. He is happy to help clubs with any queries which might save them possible wasted expense in Visa applications. It has to be emphasised that it is the Home Office that ultimately will decide the eligibility of players and **not** the Cornwall Cricket League.
